Responsibilities and tasks

- Supervising the installation and commissioning of Aircrete equipment in new and existing AAC plants worldwide;
- leading the on-site start-up operations and supervise the machine acceptance process.
- Supervise field service staff hired by Aircrete or locally by the customer;
- Providing technical project assistance and supervise in-house testing and planning preparations of the logistics supply chain, supporting the export preparations of the Aircrete equipment;
- Provide practical inputs on the production of the company systems and support the development of customized process know how (formula's, operational variables, consumptions etc.) in close communication with the Aircrete engineering team;
- Technical work preparation/checking drawing packages made by Engineering department;
